Resident Notification

Re: Port Washington Water Pollution Control District  
Replacement of 12" and 14" Diameter Siphon System  
Contract No. 116  
Notification of Work

Dear Resident,

This is to inform you that beginning in late July 2014, our contractor, G&M Earth Moving Inc., will be performing sewer installation work within the community. This will be specifically on Irma Avenue, Sandy Hollow Road, Francis Drive, Roger Drive and Glen Lane. The time of work will be between the hours of 7:30 am and 4:00 pm.

During this contract, based on the progression and location of the work, the construction crews will periodically impact vehicular access to a resident's driveway, on-street parking and traffic flow within the community.

Also, during the construction, a resident's sewer service may have to be temporarily disconnected (dependent on the location of each sewer service) from the District's mainline in the street. The duration of the temporary disconnection will be limited to 8 hours during the 7:30 am to 4:00 pm work day. It is anticipated that the work requiring the temporary disconnection of a resident's sewer service will be completed within that work day so that no further interruption in service will occur the following day or for the remaining duration of the project (only a "one time" temporary disconnection per homeowner). Residents will need to refrain, **when notified by the District/Contractor**, from the use of non-essential water. This means large volumes going down house drains, (toilet, sinks, showers), and especially the use of washing machines or dishwashers. **Failure to do so may cause wastewater to backup and discharge into the resident's basement which could cause property damage.** I sincerely wish to avoid any damages.

We will be providing weekly as well as 24-hour notice to each resident prior to a resident's driveway access being directly impacted by the construction and if necessary, when a temporary disconnection of a resident's sewer service is required (see attached examples of 7-day and 24-hour resident notification).
